Subject: Registration of Off-Highway Vehicles (ATV's, Side by Sides, Dirt bikes, Go-carts) which include golf carts. Golf carts can also be registered as a Low Speed Vehicle.

State equipment requirements for operations of an Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) on any public road way marked 55 mph and below are as follows:

- OHV registration decal – Register OHV every 2 years for \$20. Obtained at ND Department of Transportation (DOT), Motor Vehicle divisions.
- Minimum liability insurance coverage-Requirement to carry proof of insurance on OHV.
- Rear facing mirror
- A horn – Audible under normal conditions from no less than 200 ft.
- Speedometer and odometer
- Brake light.
- Lighted headlamp.
- Motor size of at least 350 cubic centimeters.
- May not operate an OHV on a paved highway if machine cannot attain a speed of at least thirty miles per hour.

Operator requirements for anyone operating an OHV on any public lands are as follows:

- Person's under the age of 18 (operator or passenger) are required to wear a DOT approved helmet.
- Anyone between 12 years of age to 16 years of age to legally operate on any public lands are required to have either a valid driver's license, learners permit or an OHV safety certification card obtained through the North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department.
- Anyone 16 years of age or over to legally operate on any public lands are required to have a valid driver's license or learner's permit.

Minimum criteria to get an OHV registered with ND DOT:

- Working headlamp, tail lamp and brakes, all in working order. Operating with these minimum requirements is limited to Right-Of-Way ditches (bottom and outslope) and OHV trails.

State equipment and registration requirements for operations of a Low Speed Vehicle on any public roadway marked 35 mph and below are as follows:

- Low Speed Vehicle registration plate – Register Low Speed Vehicle every 2 years for \$20. Obtained at ND DOT, Motor Vehicle divisions.
- Obtain a speed of no less than 20 mph but no greater than 25 mph within 1 mile distance.
- Headlamps
- Front and rear turn signal lamps
- Tail lamps
- Stop lamps
- Red reflex reflectors on either side as far back as possible
- One red reflector on the rear
- Parking brake
- Windshield
- Vehicle Identification Number
- Safety belt assembly installed at each designated seating position
- Exterior mirror mounted on the driver's side
- Either an exterior mirror mounted on the passenger's side or an interior rear view mirror.
- Operator must have a valid driver's license.

327.2 Vehicles.

- (a) This section pertains to all vehicles, including, but not limited to, automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, mini-bikes, snowmobiles, dune buggies, all-terrain vehicles, and trailers, campers, bicycles, or any other such equipment.
- (b) Vehicles shall not be parked in violation of posted restrictions and regulations, or in such a manner as to obstruct or impede normal or emergency traffic movement or the parking of other vehicles, create a safety hazard, or endanger any person, property or environmental feature. Vehicles so parked are subject to removal and impoundment at the owner's expense.
- (c) The operation and/or parking of a vehicle off authorized roadways is prohibited except at locations and times designated by the District Commander. Taking any vehicle through, around or beyond a restrictive sign, recognizable barricade, fence, or traffic control barrier is prohibited.
- (d) Vehicles shall be operated in accordance with posted restrictions and regulations.
- (e) No person shall operate any vehicle in a careless, negligent or reckless manner so as to endanger any person, property or environmental feature.
- (f) At designated recreation areas, vehicles shall be used only to enter or leave the area or individual sites or facilities unless otherwise posted.
- (g) Except as authorized by the District Commander, no person shall operate any motorized vehicle without a proper and effective exhaust muffler as defined by state and local laws, or with an exhaust muffler cutout open, or in any other manner which renders the exhaust muffler ineffective in muffling the sound or engine exhaust.
- (h) Vehicles shall be operated in accordance with applicable Federal, state, and local laws, which shall be regulated by authorized enforcement officials as prescribed in Sec. 327.26.
